Dear Parents/Guardians:

Summer School is almost here! To help us prepare, please review the information below and talk with your child about his/her classes and buses. It is very helpful if students bring their schedules with them, especially the youngest students. It is also helpful if you remind your child about the bus he/she needs to ride; some parents write that bus on their child's schedule which has been very helpful. For kindergarten and early elementary students, please review with them their last name, what grade they will be attending, where they live, and their phone number.

- Classes will be held primarily at the middle school with shuttle buses traveling to the Blue Angels Gym for gymnastics; the former Kindernook building for wrestling, the high school for basketball, football, pottery, and some cooking and babysitting classes; near Arctic Springs for fishing; Gale Elementary for Art in the Garden; and the pool from Monday, July 23 through Friday, August 10.
- Kindergartners will attend only the second and third week of summer school from July 30 to August 10, and it will be in the middle school again this year.
- Summer School hours are from 8:00 AM to 11:30 AM. There will be three sessions each day: 8:00-9:00; 9:15-10:15; 10:30-11:30. Kindergartners rotate as a group and are in session 8:00-11:30.

Buses will pick up and drop off children along the routes listed on the back of this letter. Parents may also pick up or drop off their children at the middle school. If they are being dropped off but ride a bus home, please make sure you review with your child what bus they ride.

There will be no transportation offered to or from home between classes. If your child is attending only one session, you must supply transportation at the end of the session. Your child should NOT be at the school during any period he/she does not have scheduled class time. Middle and high school students only taking one or two classes may volunteer to help other classes when they are not in session.

If you have any schedule changes, the summer school secretary Peggy Kirkey will be in the high school guidance office the week before summer school begins and can be contacted at 582-2291 ext. 1058. Summer school office hours will be Monday, July 23 through Friday, August 10 from 7:45 to 11:45 and the office can be reached at 582-3500 ext. 2011. Summer School Busing Schedule

Bus 1 Red Dog

Leaves Trempealeau Elementary at 7:15 AM. Travels west on Park Road to West Prairie Road and Spalding Road. Then travels north on Canar Road to Harris Road, and east on Highway 93/54 to Centerville stopping at the Curling Club. Continues east on 93/54, then north on Tamarack Road, Trim Road, to Sacia Road to County T ending at the middle school.

Bus 2 Green Frog

Leaves Trempealeau Elementary at 7:10 AM. Travels north on Highway 35 to Bluffview Acres. The bus will return south on Hwy. 35 turning east on Tenth Street to County Hwy. K and then turning north on Schubert Road stopping at the Prairie Bluff addition. The bus will cut through Fairway Lane to Highway 35 and head north to Centerville with a stop at the bank parking lot, then traveling east on 93/54 to Hillside Trailer Court into Ridgeview Drive and Wolfe Lane continuing on Highway 54 to Wason's Supper Club parking lot. Continues to Winnebago Road, and Little Scholars Day Care on McKeeth Drive, then north on Hwy. 53 stopping at Harris Road, and ending at the middle school.

Bus 3 Purple Pig

Leaves Trempealeau Elementary at 7:20 AM. Stops at Bumble Bee Day Care. Travels east on Highway 35 to College Street stopping at the swimming pool. Then travels north on Fremont, left on 8th Street, then north on Chase to County K to Highway 54. North on County Road T to West Gale, to Ridge Avenue then north on Main Street to the middle school.

Bus 4 Brown Monkey

Leaves Trempealeau Elementary at 7:10 AM. Travels east on Highway 35 to Bemis addition and then McDonah Lane and Coyote Lane and return to Hwy. 35 to South Street. North on County M to County K. North on County K stopping at Hollow Lane and Country Road Estates to County Road T, north to West Gale Avenue stopping at Gale Excavating, Fabian Day Care, Cance Park, and Galesville Elementary. Return to West Ridge Avenue ending at the middle school.

Bus 5 Black Cat

Leaves Ettrick Elementary at 7:20 AM. Travels west on Creamery Hill (County D) to County T, south on County T through Frenchville, continuing on County T to 4th Street east on West Ridge, north on Hwy. 53 ending at the middle school.

Bus 6 Blue Fish

Leaves Ettrick Elementary at 7:15 AM. Travels east on County D to Dopp Road. South on Dopp Road to Truax Road to Highway 53, and then south on Highway 53 to Sunset Valley Road to Angel Ridge Road to Dalton Road to Crystal Valley Road. East on Crystal Valley Road to Sampson Lane and Fabian Day Care to Gillmeister Road to Silver Creek Road, then west on Silver Creek Road stopping at Children's Palace and ending at the middle school.

Bus 7 Orange Giraffe

Starts at Highway 54 and Stuhr Road at 7:25 AM. Travels west on Highway 54 to County AA to Highway 53. West on Highway 53 and then north on Highway 53 into Galesville with stops at Ravine Drive, the karate studio, and bowling alley. Returns to Hwy. 53, stops at Thompson Street, and on to the middle school. *During Vacation Bible School at Zion Lutheran Church, students will ride this bus during the late route.
